Denis Hickey began his career as a cricketer playing for the Melbourne Cricket Club in 1981 and played for the Australian U19 team in 1984. As a right arm fast bowler he made his debut for Victoria in the Sheffield Shield in 1985, representing Victoria through until 1990 before switching and playing for South Australia for five years.

In the 1986 off season Denis headed to England to play county cricket on an Esso scholarship to play at Glamorgan Cricket Club and in 1988 he was part of the Prime Minister's XI that played a touring West Indies outfit. In 1992 Denis toured with the Australia A team through South Africa and Zimbabwe. He finished his career with 156 first class wickets with best figures of 7- 81.

Prior to committing to cricket, Denis was also a keen AFL player. In 1982 he was named in the Norm Smith scholarship squad and also represented Melbourne in the under-19 squad in 1983.

Following his sporting pursuits, Denis has worked his way to the top of the order in Australian real estate sector. He is currently based in New York and CEO of Lendlease America, responsible for all aspects of the company's investment, development and construction activities.

Prior to this Denis held several senior roles in Australia namely; Chief Executive ING Real Estate, Chief Executive Stockland Development and Chief Executive AVJennings Group.
