David is a former Australian cricketer who played in 9 Tests and 14 One Day Internationals (ODIs) from 1985 to 1986. He also played for New South Wales, Gloucestershire County Cricket Club, and the Tasmanian Tigers.

He achieved greater success at first-class level, taking over 350 wickets. Since retiring, he has taken and excelled at executive levels with Surrey County Cricket Club, Sussex County Cricket Club and the New South Wales Blues.

He was subsequently a successful coach and cricket manager for Sussex and worked as the CEO of the New South Wales Cricket Association until 2013.

Gilbert serviced as Chief Executive officer of Cricket New South Wales from 2003 to 2014. From 2014 to 2018 Gilbert was the President of Western Suburbs District Cricket Club one of the oldest and established (1895) clubs in the NSW Premier Cricket Competition. In 2006 David was selected in Western Suburbs Team of the Millennium.

Gilbert joined the Cricket Australia (CA) Supplementary Referee Panel in season 2018/19 and most recently appointed to the WNCL Final between New South Wales and Western Australia at North Sydney Oval.

David has officiated throughout the Women's A Series between Australia A and India A; Rebel WBBL; CA Under 17 National Championships; a men's Tour Match featuring Pakistan as well as WNCL minor-round matches.
